# Labor Day Holiday Schedule 2020

**EL PASO, Texas**—In observance of the Labor Day weekend, the City of El Paso administrative offices will be closed on Monday, September 7.

**Please note that many City services and facilities are impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic.**

## City Closures

- City services will not be available for phone or online customer service needs on Labor Day. Offline services include the City's One Stop Shop, Environmental Services Department and Municipal Court.
- Sun Metro bus service will run on a Sunday/Holiday schedule. Buses and Brio service that do not operate on Sundays will not run on Monday. Sun Metro's Customer Service Center will be closed. Passengers are reminded to wear a face covering and maintain social distancing when using the service. Information is available at [www.sunmetro.net](http://www.sunmetro.net).
- The Greater El Paso Landfill will be closed. The Citizen Collection Stations, which are normally closed on Mondays, and residential trash and recycling collections will not be affected by the holiday.
- As part of the response to the COVID-19 pandemic, City facilities remain closed, including public libraries (curbside closed on Labor Day), recreation centers, senior centers, aquatics facilities, sports fields and the El Paso Zoo.
