EL PASO, TEXAS: An arrest has been made in the recent West-side burglary home invasion case. On Monday, Gerald DUNN was taken into custody by U.S. Marshals in Bexar County on a warrant obtained by El Paso Police. DUNN was booked into the Bexar County Detention facility as a Wanted subject and is awaiting the process to be brought back to El Paso. The investigation was conducted The El Paso Police Department with the collaborative assistance by The F.B.I. and The U.S. Marshals Service.

EL PASO, TEXAS: Officers from the Westside Regional Command Center responded to 1600 Dede Ln in reference to a home invasion. Officers met with the victims of this aggravated assault a 91-year old male and an 88- year old female. The husband and wife couple was on their morning walk at 5:30 a.m. close to their home when the suspect followed them home. The suspect entered the Victims home as they entered through a garage door. While inside the home the suspect demanded money and assaulted the 91-year old male. The suspect then fled the scene with an undisclosed amount of money. The suspect is only described as a black male. The case is ongoing and is in the preliminary stages.
