El Paso Police Department Announces New Traffic Safety Collaboration

El Paso, Texas- A new auto and traffic safety collaboration will expand the reach of the El Paso Police Department's Safe Communities Program. The program focuses on reducing injuries and fatalities by raising awareness of drunk, distracted, drugged and drowsy driving dangers; speeding, pedestrian and car seat safety.

The program was awarded a \$20,000 grant this year by State Farm, which will help fund several traffic safety and community events. The collaboration is being formally announced Thursday October 3, 2019 at a news conference at El Paso Police Department.
